Consistency is one of the most essential and productive strategies for effective parenting. This means being consistent in your schedule, routines, and rules; in their discipline patterns; and how you connect emotionally with your child. When parents are consistent, children know what their parents want them to do. Your child will be able to predict how you will react to specific situations, such as when it's time for bed. Inconsistency can be confusing for children. When one parent is inconsistent, the child learns that adult responses are not predictable. This can cause aggression, hostility, complacency, confusion, and rebellion. Striving to be consistent can be really challenging and time-consuming. It requires reflection and patience, but it's an investment in your child's development and will strengthen your relationship as they grow.
