How do I help my child to adjust to School?

Parent Corner

Getting ready for the New School Year! Here are some tips!

- 1. Read to Your Child Every Day** Have books in your living room, your kitchen, his room, your purse, everywhere! Let your child go through the pages and pretend to be reading. Good literature will provide rich language for your child and will help him start developing skills that later on will promote reading and writing.
- 2. Teach Your Child Proper Social Skills-** Children must learn to share their toys, take turns, play with others, and have good manners. This will go a long way in the successful start of their journey.
- 3. Help Your Child Manage Their Emotions** - For instance, your child is having a temper tantrum or crying hard. Help your child by being very calm yourself and then you can tell him: "Breathe sweetie. Everything is going to be okay. You are safe. I am with you" or something like that.
- 4. Encourage Your Child's Independence and Self-Help Skills** -Parents may still see their child as a baby and want to do everything for them, but the child mustn't rely on you for everything. An independent child that knows how to take care of his/her personal needs will do much better at preschool than the ones who do not.
- 5. Establish Rituals and Routines with Consistency-** Since preschool is a more structured environment where schedules and regular practices or routines are used every day, putting rituals and routines in place at home will help your child get used to this practice.

Early School Dismissal-Friday, August 28th @ 12noon-There will be an early dismissal due to an annual staff meeting.

Summer Break-School will be closed August 31st -September 4th and Labor Day Monday, September 7th. School will reopen September 8th - Fall semester begins. Tuition is still due the week of Summer Break.

2026-2027 Registration Fee-The registration fee for returning children is \$200 per child for the year 2026-2027 will be due August 21st. This will hold your child's spot for the upcoming year. A letter will be sent to the parents who need to pay the fee.

Tuition Fees- Tuition is due on or before the Monday of each week your child starts. If your child is ill or on vacation, full tuition is due for each week. If the tuition is not paid Inglewood Avenue Preschool Academy reserves the right to discontinue childcare services.

Policy Update!!Starting September 8th Children will not be admitted after 9am. See attached flyer. Our classrooms follow a structured daily curriculum designed to help every child grow academically, socially, and emotionally. We are not baby setters. We are a learning academy!

Lillio app (Formerly HiMama)-Make sure you have downloaded the Lillio app. Parents should have gotten an invite by email. If you have not, please let Mrs. Kam know. Parents can use the Lillio app to send or receive school messages, pictures, videos and pay tuition online.

- **SIGN IN & OUT**-Your child is not enrolled for the day if you do not sign your child in and out in the roster book.
- **PRESCHOOL**- Breakfast is from 7:30am to 8:15am. **No breakfast will be served after that time.** Children will not be able to eat any outside food on campus. Class curriculum starts at 8:30am. It is important to arrive to school by 8:30am so your child does not miss out on that day's lesson. **Do not ask the staff to stop and get breakfast after 8:15am.**
- **INFANT CENTER**-Breakfast is from 7:30am to 9:00pm. **No breakfast will be served after that time.** Morning circle starts at 9:00am. It is important that the kitchen be cleaned and start the set up for lunch. **Do not ask the staff to stop and get breakfast for your child after 8:45am.**
- **Make sure your child has a change of clothes in their box. Label all items!!!!Make sure your child brings a fitted sheet and blanket. The state requires that mats/cots are covered with a fitted sheet.**
- **New Start Time!!!All Student must arrive before 9am. Students arriving after 9am will not be admitted without permission from the director or the lead teacher on duty.**

Back to School & Uniforms Starting September 8th!

Preschool Only

It is mandatory that all students come dressed in school uniforms Monday thru Thursday. Friday is school spirit day when students can wear free dress. If you are not in a school uniform, you can purchase a T-Shirt in the office.

Girls

No Backpacks-Preschoolers do not need to bring backpacks to school. Our lockers have limited space. Make sure your child's extra change of clothes and a fitted sheet and blanket for each week

Infant Center-Parents may bring a **small** diaper bag (for food and bottles, if applicable) that fits into the locker, a clear shoebox for extra clothes and reusable shopping bag for sheet and blanket.
